About Indian Community Relief Fund (ICRF)

ICRF is a non-government, non-profit organization established in the year 1999, working under the patronage of the Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Bahrain for the general welfare of the Indian workers in Bahrain. Our mission is to give a helping hand to the economically weaker section of the Indian community in Bahrain. This includes Legal Aid, Emergency Help, Community Welfare Services, Medical assistance, Counseling etc.

ICRF is managed by the Managing Council, nominated by the Ambassador of India from among leaders in the Indian Public Sectors, Indian curriculum schools and business community. The Emergency Help Team offers a 24 hour helpline for reporting any complaints of maltreatment, abuse or assault or assistance for those seeking any legitimate advice. With various regional sub-committees, the Emergency Help Team is well prepared to assist Indian nationals in emergencies like natural calamity, flood, fire etc.

ICRF- Community Welfare Services organizes medical camps as a part of their outreach activity, where Indian workers can avail medical facilities free of cost. So far we have conducted over 130 such medical camps that has benefited more than 40,000 needy persons. ICRF's Community Welfare services include, Salmaniya Mortuary visit, prison visit, Immigration detention centre visit, Immigration Directorate visit etc. During the COVID-19 pandemic ICRF has reached out to the community by providing dry food ration, Air tickets, face masks, antibacterial soaps, awareness flyers etc., which benefited over 50,000 under-privileged Indian workers.

One of the unique features of the ICRF is the Family Relief Fund, which extends financial assistance to the dependents of poor workers who perished in Bahrain. ICRF raises its funds by organizing events like SPECTRA - a yearly Drawing and Painting competition for school children and through generous contributions. So far we have given out more than 5 Crore Indian Rupees to more than 500+ families.



ICRF ACTIVITIES

MEDICAL AID (MEDICAL CAMPS & BLOOD DONATION):

- Organizes regular monthly Free Medical Camps for Indian employees who are earning lesser wages and cannot afford regular medical care. The Team will identify medical camp sites from various labour camps where Indian employees are accommodated and conducts Medical Camps after obtaining permission from the employer to organize the camp. Organizes transport and food for all participants and volunteers. The ICRF Medical Team believes in extending loving services to the underprivileged with true hall mark of self satisfaction and charity
- Maintains and updates the list of volunteers attending the camps (Doctors, Nurses and Paramedics) and adds new members to the support team regularly
- Intend to organise at least 3 Blood Donation Camps during a year in tie up with the Ministry of Health/ Salmaniya Medical Center.

LABOUR WELFARE RELATIONSHIP:

 Improving the workers feelings of concern by ensuring the basic amenities like working conditions, hours of work, proper shelter, hygiene, safety, light, ventilation, sanitation etc. Proper assessment of needs of the workers and determination of priorities. Ensure proper and adequate rest/break is given at work which will contribute to the comfort and efficiency of workers.

EMERGENCY HELP:

- Manage 24 Hours Hotline & extend assistance to Indian Nationals in emergency cases
- Coordinate the team members & extend assistance to Indian Nationals in emergency cases
- Work for harmony among Indian Nationals & extend all possible assistance in emergency situations

HOSPITAL VISIT:

- Regular visits to Salmaniya Medical Centre to:
 - Ascertain the health condition of Indian inmates and provide possible medical assistance.
 - Collect the information of inmates in need of legal/ welfare assistance & forward to the respective team head.

MORTUARY VISIT & REPATRIATION OF MORTAL REMAINS:

- Visit Salmaniya Mortuary, collect details of mortal remains of Indian Nationals.
- Provide all kinds of assistance to the families of deceased Indian National in repatriating the mortal remains.

CASE HELP:

 Extend all possible assistance to Indian Nationals who are facing police cases referred by Indian Embassy.

- Cases shall be genuine and not like theft, illegal alcohol selling, economical crimes and other types of fraud, prostitution, and any other crimes against National security.
- Propagate general awareness among Indian Nationals on the need to follow local laws & rules and regulations.
 Complaints & Follow up at Immigration.
- Extend all possible assistance to Indian Nationals in case of any requirements regarding issues relating to immigration.
- Provide assistance to Indian Nationals at Immigration for Legalization/Repatriation.
- Propagate general awareness among Indian Nationals on the need to follow Immigration Laws & Regulations.

DOMESTIC WORKER & MIGRANT PROTECTION:

- Provide assistance in protecting the basic human rights of needy Indian Nationals.
- Provide temporary shelters for destitute Indian housemaids.

FAMILY WELFARE FUND DISBURSEMENT:

- To provide assistance for claiming the compensation from ICRF Family Welfare Fund in cases of accidents at work and traffic.
- Follow up on the claim settlement.
- Assist the legal heir of the deceased Indian National to process the necessary legal papers to receive the compensation money.

SPECTRA PAINTING CARNIVAL:

- Successfully organize Annual Spectra Painting Carnival.
- Prepare an Action Plan/Road Map and form subcommittees.
- Coordinating the sub-committee activities.
- Finalize the rules & regulations of Spectra.
- Supervises the functioning of all other committees
- Plan and execute Spectra Art Carnival in a befitting manner.

ICRF LIFE (Listen, Involve, Foster, Engage):

- Handles calls from people on distress, depression or anxiety and provide advice on mental well-being.
- Organize seminar for adults, whether parents, teachers or friends to interact with children continuously in order to equip them the strength and understanding to face the challenges they might come across.

ICRF YOGA:

- Organises yoga sessions in labour camps
- Create awareness among labourers on healthy diet, sleep and exercise.





ONLINE INTERACTION WITH LABOURERS - 14TH MAY 2021



ICRF has organised a series of Online Interactions with various Labor Camps. The first of the series was held on 14th May 2021at Chapo Labor Camp located in Ras Zuwayed. His Excellency Piyush Srivastava, the Ambassador of India to Bahrain was the Chief Guest of the event. His Excellency addressed the workers online and advised the workers to

follow all the guidelines and precautions as announced by the government of the Kingdom of Bahrain including joining the free vaccination drive initiated by the government. His Excellency also congratulated ICRF for this wonderful initiative of reaching out to the community members during the Eid celebrations.

Dr Babu Ramachandran briefed the workers on the importance of vaccination which plays a significant role in the fight against Covid-19 in addition to the practice of washing hands, using masks and maintaining social distance.

Chief Guest of the event was His Excellency Mr Ahmed Al-Haiki, Assistant Undersecretary for Labour Affairs at the Ministry of Labour & Social Affairs.

His Excellency addressed the workers online and advised them to follow the guidelines and instructions issued by the company and government regarding health and safety. "The number of fatal accidents have been reduced drastically over the last three years. The Ministry's aim is to have zero fatal accidents in Bahrain" he said.

He also mentioned that he is very happy to be associated with ICRF team who are helping the Ministry of Labour in making the life of workers happy and safe.

Dr Babu Ramachandran briefed the workers on the importance of vaccination which plays a significant role in the fight against Covid-19 in addition to the practice of washing hands, using masks and maintaining social distance.

This scheme has been a great support and help to many unfortunate families, who lost their bread winner. The scheme from its inception has supported hundreds of families.

So far we have given out more than 5 Crore Indian Rupees to more than 500+ families. Over the last 18 months we have extended support to 51 families (Indian Rupees 51 lakhs).
